 - The study of values is prominent both in psychology and economy. Contrary to the long history of theoretical axiology, the empirical research of values has a much shorter tradition. On the basis of the empirical studies of values, a comprehensive model of human values can be built including the structural (descriptive), developmental, cross-cultural and etiological (causal) aspects of values, as well as the relationships between values and other major domains of personality (motivation, personality dimensions, intellect and cognition, emotions, well-being and health). According to this model, the entire structural hierarchy of human values encompasses four levels differing in the generality of value categories or dimensions. The hierarchy extends from the bottom level of single general values through the levels of the middle-order dimensions and higher-order dimensions of values to the top level of two superdimensions of values (Apollonian and Dionysian values). In economy and economic psychology, the empirically based model of values is of importance in the light of the changing the homo economicus perspective to the behavioral economics perspective. In order to obtain more efficient predictions of human behavior, the contemporary economy and economical psychology should more properly reflect and consider the entire spectrum of the principal human values, which is much broader than the value systems being considered in classical economy.

 - Starting from the three-dimensional model of personality we can conceive the human personality as a holistic entity being determined by physical, psychosocial and spiritual level of functioning. An integral comprehension of the personality inevitably included the spiritual dimension comprised of ideas, goals and values. This dimension could be most appropriately represented by human capacity of achieving the full meaning of the life which is according to some psychological and anthropological theories one of the most basic motivational force. In general, the sense or the meaning of the life could be defined as an experience of identifying a positive meaning and perspective in individual's long-term as well as daily existence. On the other side, humor could be regarded as an important psychological mechanism which enables us to experience the life events from the positive point of view. This could be accomplished by two ways: first, the humor alleviates the negative impacts of the stress, and second, it makes the transcendence of current situation more easy and promising. Therefore, humor can be logically associated with the meaning of the life in the sense that it can detach us emotionally and spiritually from the restrictions and problems of immediate reality rendering thus our life more positive and meaningful.

 - Nowadays, the crisis of values and the moral crisis of humanity are quite commonly used terms. Nevertheless, the moral crisis and the crisis of values have been encountered in past times also and maybe the most accurate observation could be expressed by the statement that each human generation lives and deals with its own crisis in a specific way. What has psychology to say about our contemporaneous crisis of values, of morality and of the spiritual state of mankind? The analysis of the conceptions of moral and valuecrisis compels us to distinguish more clearly between different events concerning the values, like the vacuum of values, the confusion of values and the conflict of values. In many respects the crisis of values appears prevalently in the form of confusion and conflict in the value systems. Psychology could clarify many puzzling phenomena implicated in the relationship between our values and our behavior. Many aspects of the sometimes astonishing gap extending between the values and the factual behavior could be explained by psychological factors. Psychological discoveries revealing the inner structure of individual values and the developmental hierarchy of values could help us to overcome better the permanent human crisis regarding our valuing, moral and personal conduct. By following the natural development of value orientation, a human being could succesfully cope with moral and other personal problems.
